Why do people work hard, and take pride in what they do? El clima siempre está

cambiando, con o sin influencia humana. Las tormentas, temporales y huracanes no son más fuertes ni más frecuentes que en el pasado. El Medioevo fue significativamente más cálido que hoy, y fue una edad dorada para la agricultura, la innovación y la expansión de la vida. El polo norte se está calentando, pero el polo sur se está enfriando. Las mediciones de temperatura no indican tendencias “globales”. Aún así, si aceptáramos el método de “las temperaturas medias”, lo que se ha producido es un descenso de las mismas desde 1998.
